

## Political Studies

Political Studies is an interdisciplinary program intended to provide a broad approach to the study of politics. A Political Studies minor introduces students to varied ways of understanding politics and government by taking a set of courses in different disciplines that focus on those subjects. (See the History and Political Science listing for descriptions of courses in those fields.)

A total of 18 hours is required for a minor in Political Studies. The minor requires 6 courses from the following list:

- Political Science 203: American Politics
- Political Science 215: International Politics
- Either History 355: The History of Political Campaigning or History 362: The U.S. Presidency
- One of the following: History 341: Era of the American Revolution, History 342: Early American Republic or History 350: History of the Americas
- One of the following: Criminal Justice 318: Constitutional Law, Sociology 300: Social Justice or Philosophy 220: Contemporary Ethics
- Either one of the above history courses not yet chosen or History 477: Historical Research
