

INDEPENDENT STUDY REGISTRATION

The purpose of Independent Study is to study material outside the regular curriculum as listed in the current catalog. Courses listed in the catalog will be taught as regular classes or Directed Study and cannot be taken as Independent Study. Independent Studies are usually initiated and organized by the student. There is no extra fee for Independent Study.

To be eligible for Independent Study, a student must have a grade point average of at least 3.00 cumulative or in the immediate preceding semester. The course is subject to the willingness of a faculty advisor to supervise the study and approval by the Registrar. Independent Study may be for two, three, or four credit hours. It is limited to four credit hours a semester and eight hours total.

This form is to be completed by the faculty supervisor and returned by the student to the Office of Records & Registration, Kathryn Hall 309-312. The student will not be permitted to register for the course until this form is on file in that office.
