

# MacMurray College's Transfer Guide

## For John Wood Community College Students

John Wood credits are fully transferable to MacMurray College, except for certain vocational-technical courses. Students will receive transfer credit, up to 60 hours, for courses successfully taken with grades of C– or better.

MacMurray participates in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). Therefore:

**Students who have completed the Illinois General Education Core Curriculum:**

❖ **will have satisfied MacMurray's lower division requirements (listed below).**

**In addition, students who earn an *Associate in Arts* or *Associate in Science* degree:**

❖ **will be granted 60 transfer credits (junior standing) at MacMurray.**

If students have not completed the entire General Education Core Curriculum, the following courses will satisfy the individual general education requirements at MacMurray.

### MacMurray Requirement

### What to do at John Wood

Mac 101 (Orientation to college).....PSY 105 or two full-time semesters or equivalent at John Wood.

Rhetoric sequence (3 courses) .....ENG 101 and 102 and CMN 101.

Math 121 (1 course)

(Mathematics for Liberal Arts) ....MAT 105, 108, or 113, or a calculus course, or ACT math subscore 27 or higher.

### *Breadth courses:*

Natural Sciences (with lab, 1 course) Introductory lab course in biology, chemistry, geology, meteorology, or physics: BIO 101, 102, 111, 221, 275, 293; CHE 100, 103, 105; PHY 101, 103, 223; SCI 100, 105.

Social Sciences (1 course) .....Introductory course in economics, history, political science, psychology, or sociology: ECO 101, 102; HIS 101, 102, 111, 112, 121, 122; PSC 100, 101, 110, 131; PSY 101, 108, 145; SOC 101, 103, 111.

Humanities (1 course).....Introductory course in literature, philosophy, religion, or language: HUM 101, 200; ENG 114,130, 211, 231, 232, 241, 242, 251, 255; PHL 101, 121, 201, 211; RST 101, 105, 111, 112; or one semester of a foreign language.

Fine Arts (1 course) .....Introductory course in art, drama, or music: ART 100, 106, 111, 115, 120, 126, 211, 245; DRA 101, 225; MUS 100, 102, 121.

### *Upper division general education requirements, not available at John Wood:*

Issues of Community and Conflict

sequence (3 courses) .....Three MacMurray IOCC courses required; two if the student brings 60 credit hours.

Cultural Studies 300 (1 course).....Diversity and the American Experience.

Junior-level writing exam .....Essay exam to be taken at MacMurray after junior standing is reached.

*MacMurray will send an official evaluation of transfer credit after a MacMurray application has been accepted, and after the official John Wood transcript has been received.*
