

**MacMurray College's
Transfer Guide
For Lincoln Land Community College Students**

Lincoln Land credits are fully transferable to MacMurray College, except for certain vocational-technical courses. Students will receive transfer credit, up to 60 hours, for courses successfully taken with grades of C– or better.

In addition, MacMurray participates in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). Therefore:

Students who have completed the Illinois General Education Core Curriculum:

❖ **will have satisfied MacMurray's lower division requirements (listed below).**

In addition, students who earn an *Associate in Arts* or *Associate in Science* degree:

❖ **will be granted 60 transfer credits (junior standing) at MacMurray.**

If students have *not* completed the entire General Education Core Curriculum, the following courses will satisfy the individual general education requirements at MacMurray.

MacMurray Requirement	What to do at Lincoln Land
Mac 101 (Orientation to college).....	Two full-time semesters or equivalent at Lincoln Land.
Rhetoric sequence (3 courses)	COM 111 and 112 and SPE 101.
Math 121 (1 course)	
(Mathematics for Liberal Arts)	Either MAT 104 or MAT 113, or a calculus course, or ACT math subscore 27 or higher.
<i>Breadth courses:</i>	
Natural Sciences (with lab, 1 course)	Introductory lab course in biology, chemistry, geology, or physics: BIO 101, 104, 111, 201; CHE 100, 101; GEO 101; PHY 101, 201.
Social Sciences (1 course)	Introductory course in anthropology, economics, history, political science, psychology, or sociology: ANT 101, 201, 205; ECO 110, 131, 132; HIS 101, 102, 111, 112, 147, 211, 212, 215, 250, 260; POS 101, 201, 202, 210, 211; PSY 101, 147; SOC 101, 110, 201.
Humanities (1 course).....	Introductory course in literature, philosophy, religion, or language: HUM (all courses), LIT 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 120, 147, 201, 202, 210, 211, 220, 221, 222; PHI 204, 205, 210; or one semester foreign language.
Fine Arts (1 course)	Introductory course in art, creative writing, music, oral interpretation, or theatre: ART 101, 102, 103, 115, 116, 118, 123, 124, 204, 205, 206, 208; FLM 101; FNA 101; LIT 150, 151; MUS 100, 104, 108; SPE 212; THE 101, 102, 201.

Upper division general education requirements, not available at Lincoln Land:

Issues of Community and Conflict sequence (3 courses)	Three MacMurray IOCC courses required; only two are required if the student brings 60 credit hours.
Cultural Studies 300 (1 course).....	Diversity and the American Experience
Junior-level writing proficiency exam	Not a course, but an essay exam to be taken at MacMurray after junior standing is reached.

MacMurray will send an official evaluation of transfer credit after a MacMurray application has been accepted, and after the official Lincoln Land transcript has been received.
