- **86% of 2010 graduates** surveyed reported being **employed in a position related to their major** within one year after graduation
- One of the **most affordable** private colleges in Illinois
 - ♦ Annual full-time tuition \$19,900 (locked in for two years with continuous full-time enrollment)
 - ♦ 98% of students receive scholarships or other financial aid
- In the **2011 National Survey of Student Engagement** of 538,000 students at 750 colleges in the country, MacMurray students reported significantly:
 - ♦ higher student-faculty interaction
 - ♦ more supportive campus environment

- **NCAA Division III:**
