## MacMurray Art Professor displays work in Chicago Exhibition



JACKSONVILLE, Ill. –

MacMurray's Khara Koffel, Assistant Professor of Art, is featured in an art exhibition in the Woman Made Gallery in Chicago, Illinois. The pieces "By Whatever Means Necessary" and "The Inescapable Inevitable" will be on

display through February 25, 2010. An artist reception will be held on Friday, February 12.

"My current body of work is a process of recollection in which I create objects that retain familiar images, which not only relate to my life, but hopefully to that of the viewer," said Koffel.

Koffel, who teaches classes that range from 3-D Design to Photography, began her faculty appointment at MacMurray College in 2004. She earned a Master of Fine Arts in sculpture from the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa in 2003, where she taught as a professor of record for a number of years in the sculpture program. Her

undergraduate work was completed at Juniata College, a liberal arts college in Huntingdon, Pennsylvania, where she received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Studio Arts and Art History.
