SLIAC named Mac's Brady Slagle as Player of the Week



JACKSONVILLE, Ill. – The St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SLIAC) has named MacMurray men's basketball freshman, **Brady Slagle**, as the SLIAC Player of the Week for January 25-31.

Slagle, a 6-5 guard from Winchester, Ill, averaged 20.0 points and eight rebounds in two games played last week. He also had five assists, two blocks, one steal and shot 15-of-26 (.577) from the field.

Slagle recorded career highs in points (21), rebounds (7), blocks (2) and assists (5) in MacMurray's 95-93 come-from-behind overtime victory at Eureka College. He blocked Eureka's Kameron Bell's shot with 34 seconds left to play in overtime, recovered the ball to preserve the tie and set up CJ McClellan's game-winning shot. Slagle added 19 points and broke his career-high in rebounds with nine in the

Highlander's second straight overtime victory, 73-71, over Webster University. The MacMurray men's basketball team is second in their conference.
