JACKSONVILLE, Ill. – The MacMurray College women's basketball team will host two Pink Zone games to help support awareness for breast cancer on Wednesday, Feb 10 at 6:00 p.m. against Fontbonne University, and Saturday, Feb 13 at 1:00 p.m. against Westminster College. Both games will be played in Wall Gymnasium in Jacksonville.

“Our women's basketball is participating in the WBCA (Women's Basketball Coaches Association) Pink Zone in order to raise breast cancer awareness on campus as well as in the Jacksonville Community,” said Annie Ewing, Women's Head Coach. “By wearing pink, selling pink t-shirts and providing cancer facts to the campus at our two games, we hope to demonstrate the importance of getting involved in the fight against breast cancer.”

All monies raised and donated will go to the WBCA's charity Kay Yow/WBCA Cancer Fund in partnership with the V Foundation. According to WBCA, “the 2009 campaign has raised over \$1.3 million, reached more than 912,000 fans and unified more than 1,600 participating teams.”
