JACKSONVILLE, Ill. – The MacMurray College men’s basketball team is one of four teams earning the honor to play in the St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference(SLIAC) post season tournament. The Highlanders are ranked #2 in the Conference and play #3 Eureka College at 6:00pm on Thursday February 25. As is tradition, the #1 seed hosts the playoff tournament, to be played this year at Westminster College in Fulton, MO. Westminster will play the #4 seed Webster University.

“The team has played well all season and has really come on strong recently” said Interim Sports Information Director Eric Green, “Coach Todd Creal has done a great job with the team this year and the entire campus is rallying behind them.”

The winner of the semi-final games will play in the championship game on Saturday February 27, 2010. The SLIAC Champion will earn a place in the NCAA Division III Tournament.
