Slagle, Creal take top conference honors

St. Louis – The St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference has announced that MacMurray College's **Brady Slagle** is the 2010 SLIAC Newcomer of the Year. Slagle, a 6-5 guard from Winchester, Ill., averaged 14.1 points per game in conference play this season, shooting 86-of-164 (.524) from the field and grabbing 4.5 rebounds per game.



Following the conference tournament last week, SLIAC named MacMurray College's men's basketball coach **Todd Creal** the co-winner of the 2010 SLIAC Coach of the Year award. Creal is in his third year as the head of the Highlanders and led the squad to an 11-5 conference record and a second place regular season finish.

Creal shared the award with Westminster College's Matt Mitchell.

Also recognized for their fine play were Highlanders **Marc Randle**, who was named to the SLIAC All-Defensive Team, and **CJ McClellan**, who was named to the All-Conference Second Team. Randle and **Ryan Sichting** were named All-Conference Honorable Mention.
