MacMurray College to host music festival

JACKSONVILLE, Ill. – MacMurray Concert Choir is hosting a music festival, “MacAppalooza,” showcasing a lineup of local bands.

MacAppalooza begins 5:30 p.m. Friday, March 19 until 9:30 p.m. and resumes 1 p.m. Saturday, March 20 until 9:30 p.m. All performances will be at MacMurray’s Annie Merner Chapel, on the northeast corner of College Avenue and Clay Street in Jacksonville.

The cost is \$5 for MacMurray and Illinois College students and \$10 for adults. Children younger than 5 years old are free, and families of three or more will pay no more than \$15.

The line-up includes such local bands as Jeff Davidsmeyer and Friends and the Rob Killam Trio. Proceeds will help fund the MacMurray choir’s scheduled trip to New York City in June, when the choir has been invited to perform at Carnegie Hall.
