ONLINE PROGRAM ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Submit the Business Administration application for admission found at www.mac.edu/online_programs/index.asp
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher if in high school
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 if transferring from another college
 - ◆ Students with fewer than 24 transferable credit hours are reviewed based on high school record.

TRADITIONAL PROGRAM ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Submit the Business Administration application for admission found at www.mac.edu/apply

FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS:

- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher if in high school
- ACT/SAT scores (unless 24 college credits have been earned)

TRANSFER STUDENTS:

- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher if transferring from another college
 - ◆ Students with fewer than 24 transferable credit hours are reviewed based on high school record.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED

- Official high school and college transcripts from all institutions attended
- Copy of Photo ID (driver's license or passport)
- ACT/SAT scores if fewer than 24 credits earned (required for traditional program only)
